Road Reports: John Clifford, road commissioner has reported that he has cleared the pine tree off Black Mountain Rd.

Wayne Miller will be accompanying Frank Robey of Stoneham and the Maine Forest Service on a helicopter flight to do an aerial survey of the town.

New Business: Appointment of Eric Gulbrandson of Lovell as Code Enforcement Officer. Alberta Ridlon, Town Clerk, swore in Mr. Gulbrandsen. All three selectmen signed. Mr. Gulbrandsen will be taking test for plumbing inspection and building code training on Monday, March 28.
