## Town of Sweden Selectmen's Meeting November 13, 2012

Attendance: Lori Bennett, Kristin Venza, DJ Curtis, Alberta Ridlon, Dick & Kathleen Lyman, Dell Foss, Marcia Storkerson, Ron Kiesman, Eric Gulbrandson.

Lori called for the Pledge of Allegiance at 6PM and then called the meeting to order.

Lori made a motion to approve the minutes for the October 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting. This was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristin, voted and approved.

Richard Lyman, from the Sweden Historical Society brought up the possibility of the town purchasing the Brick School House from the Church and then leasing it to the historical society. The Selectmen suggested that the society write up an article to put in the warrant for town meeting. Ron Kiesman surveyed the property for this and the Town Hall. He requested \$200.00 to pay for the posts required to mark the lines. Lori made a motion to okay this, Kristin 2<sup>nd</sup> it, voted and passed. Also, a discussion was held on the upcoming bicentennial for the Town of Sweden. Kay will bring in names to recommend for a committee to be appointed by the Selectmen.

CEO- Eric Gulbrandson: Sent a letter of compliance to CMP for the roadside coverage by June 2013. Brought in his report for October.

Some logging is being done on Lee Gray Rd. It appears someone went into the ditch nearby. This should be looked into.

Finance – DJ: Gave Selectmen a copy of the budget sheet with the last 3 years history and cash sheets for last 3 warrants. All accounts for 2012 are in good condition and discussions mostly now are on budget for 2013.

Town Clerk – Alberta: Had an enrollment for ACO for advanced rabies needs. Lori made motion to have Warren attend. This was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristin and passed.

Fire Dept. – Corin Meehan: They had 3 calls during Tropical Storm, Sandy. New engine is in service and Engine 1 is out for new tire replacement. The station has been scraped and painting is being done according with the weather. They are trying to button up any areas where heat is escaping to help with the heating. They are working on fund raising ideas.

Roads – John Clifford: John was not available, Lori reported that pot holes would be patched on Plummer School/Ledge hill roads this week. Lori is still trying to contact the people about the guard rails for Hardscrabble and Plummer School Roads. Nate York will take care of putting a new lock on the sand shed. All roads except Trull Brook have been graded.

The selectmen signed an abatement.

The Town Clerk talked about looking for a handy man to do the necessary things around the town office and hall. Lori is to contact Paul Perry to see if he might be interested.

Lori made motion to adjourn at 7:37 pm. Kristin 2<sup>nd</sup> it, voted and passed.
