Selectmen's Meeting  
December 18, 2012

Wayne called for the Pledge of Allegiance at 6 pm and then called the meeting to order.

Wayne made a motion to accept the minutes of December 11 meeting. This was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristin, voted and passed.

Marilyn Smith was here to make an official complaint regarding plowing and sanding of the roads.

Finance – DJ: excused

Town Clerk – Alberta had no new items.

Fire Department – Corin: Had 1 call to a motor vehicle crash. New truck has new lettering on it. Town had a 2<sup>nd</sup> thermal imaging camera charger donated. Hazmat Refresher courses are coming up with Bridgton, Sebago and Sweden together. He's working on the budget for 2013. The ladder test had to be rescheduled. He is working on the fire Dept. inventory for 2012. All members are up to date on their NIMS requirements.

Roads – John Clifford: could not be here. The report was given by Lori Bennett. Sand shed repairs have been done. The lights were repaired by McIver Electric and new locks were put on all doors so no one can move the big sliding doors from outside. This was done by Nate York. Winter Road Contract: We've had multiple phone calls regarding poor road conditions after the storm. Even the salt delivery truck complained. People feel that he is not out plowing early enough to clear the roads for those who have to work or have other commitments. Brian was approached with the problems. He said he would be out earlier. We will be watching his progress with the next storm. Two trucks are still not inspected. Lori called Motor Vehicle CDL department and was told GVW 26000 does not require a CDL license.

Lori read the minutes from December 18 meeting with Brian and Mason Molloy.

Wayne made motion to accept the minutes, Lori 2<sup>nd</sup> and they were approved. Kristin abstained because she was not at the meeting.

Wayne is to call MMA regarding inspection stickers and what exposure the town has. Then Lori will contact Brian regarding the matter of stickers and performance.

Old Business: Lori brought in a form to adopt a Key Policy. Lori made a motion to adopt the key policy as written. It was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristin and approved.

Sarah Rose requested permission to mail a check weekly to the Secretary of State for the vehicle licenses. This would mean that people could write only one check to the town. Wayne made a

motion to have citizens pay the town one check for their vehicle license and Sarah would send a check to the state weekly. This was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristin, voted and approved.

Wayne made a motion to adjourn at 7:47 pm, was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristin and approved.
