Adjacent to other water bodies, tributary streams, and wetlands, a "well-distributed stand of trees and other vegetation" is defined as maintaining a minimum rating score of 16 per 25-foot by 50-foot rectangular area. Use additional paper if necessary. Additionally, within 250' of the water no more than 40% of the total volume of trees within a 10 year period may be removed.
